Standox Painting Systems



Working Process:



Blending-in with Standohyd Basecoat into adjacent panels

Substrate:

 Prepare new panels as usual, see Standox Painting System S3

Pretreatment / Cleaning:

• Sand adjacent areas with P1000-P1200 and go over the whole panel with an ultra fine pad.



For substrate preparation information see Standox Painting System S1.

Painting:

- Apply Standohyd Basecoat to repair area to achieve opacity.
- Flash off until matt. Air blowers are recommended to reduce working time.
- Mix RFU Standohyd Basecoat 1:1 with Standohyd Color Blend.
- Fade out into adjacent panels with reduced spray pressure (by 0.5 - 1.0 bar).
- Apply one spray pass of Standocryl VOC Clear on blending-in area. After flash-off time apply Standocryl VOC Clears over complete area.

Option:

- First apply one spray pass of Standohyd Color Blend to repair and fade out area, but not up to undamaged edges of panels.
- Follow with procedure as described.
