Substrate:	<ul> <li>Prepare new panels as usual, see Standox Painting System S3</li> </ul>
Pretreatment / Cleaning:	<ul> <li>Sand the repair area with P500 and sand the whole panel with an ultra fine pad or P1000-3000 disc.</li> </ul>

Painting:	<ul> <li>Apply Standoblue Color Blend to surrounding fade out area or adjacent panels with closed coats.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Apply 1 coat Standoblue Basecoat up to the edge of the Standoblue Color Blend and extend into adjacent area / panel.</li> <li>Follow by spraying effect coat to make blend-in to the wet Standoblue Color Blend.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Apply Standoblue Basecoat to remaining repaired area (filler) with normal 1.5 coat process.</li> </ul>
